IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting Selectmen of Certain Municipalities to Act as Voting Registrars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3-A, § 6, amended. The first paragraph of section 6 of chapter 3-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

'The municipal officers of each municipality of more than 2,500 population shall appoint in writing a qualified person as registrar of voters within 10 days after the regular election of municipal officials. The selectmen of municipalities of less than 2,500 population shall perform the duties of the registrar under this chapter.'
