# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Manufacture of Foreign Lobster Meat for Newburgs and Stews by Wholesale Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37-A, § 72, sub-§ II, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection II of section 72 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:
  - 'B. The meat must be possessed for the purpose of canning or freezing it for resale as processed stews, newburgs, chowders or pies in the retail trade and notwithstanding the other provisions of this subsection if such lobster meat conforms to the legal standards of the states or counties from which it originates.'
