SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 453, L. D. 1345, Bill, "An Act

Amending Certain Provisions of the Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined designated paragraph "C." of subsection XVII of section 2.

Further amend said Bill by relettering paragraph D of subsection XVII of section 2 to be paragraph 'C.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated subsection "VII." of section 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"'VII. Witness fees. Witnesses subpoenaed pursuant to
the-previsions-of this chapter shall be allowed fees at a rate fixed
by the commission to be paid out of the Employment Security
Administration Fund, except that no attendance or mileage fee shall
be due or payable when a subpoena is issued to compel an employing
unit to appear and produce records and reports for the purpose of
making a determination as to liability or for the purpose of
completing routine reports as provided under this chapter.'"
Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 8 to be
sections 1 to 7.
