SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 453, L. D. 1345, Bill, "An Act
Amending Certain Provisions of the Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 5, a new section 5-A,
to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-A. R. S., c. 29, §5, sub-§VIII, amended. Subsection
VIII of section 5 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended
by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'In any hearings under this chapter, either before the
commission or an appeal tribunal, representatives of the
press shall be permitted to be present and they may report
to the public any or all of the proceedings at such hearings;
except that at executive sessions conducted in accordance
with chapter 1, section 39, the press may be excluded.' "
