**AN ACT Relating to Transmittal to Secretary of State of Court Record of
Appeal from Conviction Relative to Motor Vehicles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 165, amended. The first sentence of section 165 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 227 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

‘Every court and trial justice in every case wherein a person is convicted of the violation of any statute **or appeals from any conviction** relative to motor vehicles or to the operation of any vehicle shall forthwith transmit to the Secretary of State an abstract, duly certified, setting forth therein the names of the parties, the nature of the offense, the date of hearing, the plea, the judgment and the result; and in cases involving any violation of sections 112 to 113-C the abstract shall contain the legal speed involved and the speed of which the person was convicted; and they shall be open to public inspection during reasonable hours.’
