HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to H. P. 930, L. D. 1364, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Operating Business on Sunday and
Certain Holidays."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
section:

'Sec. 3. Application. Notwithstanding any other
provision in section 38 of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes
to the contrary, any store which did legally operate on the
Lord's Day preceding the effective date of this act shall be
allowed to continue to operate on the days set forth in said
section 38.'
