## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Funds for Treatment, Care and Rehabilitation of Alcoholics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 14-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 14-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 14-A. Funds for treatment of alcoholics. Necessary funds for the treatment, care and rehabilitation of alcoholics shall be made available from current liquor revenue.

Expenses incurred by the Division of Alcoholic Rehabilitation, the Department of Health and Welfare or the Department of Mental Health and Corrections in providing such service to and for alcoholics shall be a proper charge against current liquor revenue.

Hospitals and clinics, providing care and treatment for alcoholics, shall be reimbursed for such care and treatment in the same manner as presently reimbursed for state aid cases and such reimbursement shall be a proper charge against current liquor revenue.'
