STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Application of the Christmas Tree Law to Knox,
Lincoln and Waldo Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 67-K, additional. Chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 67-K, to read as follows:

'Sec. 67-K. Application. Section 67-A, section 67-C, subsection II, as it relates to registration of Christmas trees, sections 67-E, 67-F and 67-I shall not apply to Christmas trees cut in Knox, Lincoln and Waldo Counties.'
