AN ACT Exempting Nonprofit Organizations from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ XV-A, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection XV-A, to read as follows :

'XV-A. Nonprofit organizations. Merchandise sold or for which donations are received by nonprofit organizations where the proceeds are to be used for charitable purposes, meaning to grant the exemption to all those organizations now exempt from taxation under the general laws regarding real and personal property.'
