STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Junk Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 26-B, additional. Chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new section 26-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 26-B. Tax on junk motor vehicles. Assessors of municipalities shall give public notice prior to April 1st that all inoperable or so-called junk motor vehicles, or operable motor vehicles on which the excise tax has not been paid, found in yards or fields and which are visible from streets or highways after the following June 1st shall be taxed as personal property.'
