IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Exempting Certain Elderly Persons from Real Estate Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ VI, ¶ G, additional. Subsection VI of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new paragraph G, to read as follows:

'G. The real estate of all persons 65 years of age and over and who have been legal residents of Maine for at least 5 years. To be eligible for such an exemption, the person, if married and living with his spouse, shall not have total income, including pensions and retirement benefits of any nature, in excess of \$3,000; if single, shall not have such total income in excess of \$1,700.'
