## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Distribution of State Tax in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 77-C, amended. The last paragraph of section 77-C of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 128 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'The sum so collected from each township and each lot or parcel of land not included in any township in the State shall be disbursed by the Treasurer of State to each township and each lot or parcel of land not included in any township which is assessed for school or highway purposes in an amount not to exceed  $\frac{3}{4}$  100% of the amount assessed for school and highway purposes and shall be credited to such purposes.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is estimated that this bill will mean the loss of revenue to the State of approximately \$20,000 per year.
