IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Tie Rod Locks for Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 39-B, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 39-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 39-B. Tie rod locks on steering assembly. No person shall operate upon any public way any passenger car, taxicab, commercial motor vehicle, motor truck or trailer unless there is a tie rod lock attached to the steering assembly on all such motor vehicles.'
