AN ACT Providing for a Pine Tree in Lieu of a Hyphen on Motor Vehicle Registration Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 18, amended. Section 18 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence, a new sentence to read as follows :

‘The figure of a pine tree of appropriate size and color shall be stamped on the plates in place of a hyphen to indicate a division in the numerical arrangement of the register number.’
