IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Official Tree of the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 1, § 26-A, amended. Section 26-A of chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 363 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 26-A. State tree. The official tree of the State shall be the eastern white pine tree.'
