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**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Leeman Grant of  
Columbia Falls.**

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**Leeman Grant; state pension increased. Resolved:** That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Leeman Grant, of Columbia Falls, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1963, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 59 of the resolves of 1943 which provides for a state pension for Leeman Grant, of Columbia Falls, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Grant is 77 years of age. He was hurt in an accident and is unable to work. He needs more aid.
