STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to the Unorganized Territory Capital Working

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, on January 10th the Connor elementary school in the unorganized territory burned; and

Whereas, a new building is required for the opening of school in September; and

Whereas, the insurance will not provide sufficient funds to pay for constructing a new building and purchasing necessary equipment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for construction of an elementary school in Connor. In order to provide for the construction of an elementary school in Connor, Maine, there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$50,000 to the Department of Education Unorganized Territory Capital Working Fund.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
