# RESOLVE, Providing a World War I Bonus for George E. Maroon of Lewiston.

World War I bonus of \$100 granted to George E. Maroon. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$100 to be paid to George E. Maroon of Lewiston, as his World War I bonus.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The records show that Mr. Maroon previously applied for a World War I bonus but the request was denied because at that time he had a bad conduct discharge. Since the time the records were first checked his records have been changed to show his discharge was honorable and further he has now been paid the Federal World War I bonus. He also served honorably in World War II.
