RESOLVE, in Favor of Reed Plantation.

Reed Plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,166.50 to be paid to Reed Plantation, to reimburse it for aid given to the family of Donat Voisine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is a welfare claim for supplies furnished the family of Donat Voisine. Reed Plantation expected to collect from a settlement in Fort Kent but were unable to do so. This claim is now about 4 years old and is for the sum of \$1,166.50.
