STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Defenses for Employers Employing Five or Less Workmen Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 31, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

'The provisions of section 3 shall not apply to employers who employ 5 or less workmen or operatives regularly in the same business'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 31, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 343 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Said provisions Section 3 shall not apply to actions to recover damages for the injuries aforesaid, or for death resulting from such injuries, sustained by employees engaged in domestic service or in agriculture.'
