IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Escapes from Custody of Police Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 135, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 135 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 28. Escape from custody of police officers or jail. Whoever, being lawfully detained in any jail or other place of confinement, except the State Prison, breaks or escapes therefrom, or attempts to do so, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 7 years; the. The sentence to such imprisonment shall not be concurrent with any other sentence then being served or thereafter to be imposed upon such escape. Whoever resists apprehension or breaks arrest shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months.'
