HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 984, L.D. 1426, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Number of Signatures on Nomination Papers
for Town Officers"

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 9th, 10th,
11th and 12th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:
"in towns of 1,000 ~~or less population~~ to 4,000; ~~50 in towns of~~
~~1,001 to 4,000~~; not less than 75 nor more than 125 in towns of
4,001 to 10,000; and not less than 100 nor more than 150 in towns
of more than 10,000."
