SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 991, L. D. 1434, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Eliminating Requirements Relating to Warrants for Public Money and Publication of Receipts and Expenditures.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of that part designated "Section 4." and inserting in place thereof the following:

"'Section 4. No money drawn except upon appropriation.

No money shall be drawn from the treasury; but-by-warrants-from the-Governer-and-Council; and except in consequence of appropriations or allocations authorized made by law; and a regular-statement-and-account-of-the-receipts-and-expenditures of-all-public-money; shall-be-published-at-the-commencement of-the-biennial-session-of-the-Legislature."
