SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 991, L. D. 1434, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution Eliminating Requirements
Relating to Warrants for Public Money and Publication of
Receipts and Expenditures.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of that part
designated "Section 4." and inserting in place thereof the
following:

"Section 4. No money drawn except upon appropriation.
No money shall be drawn from the treasury, ~~but by warrants from~~
~~the Governor and Council,~~ and except in consequence of appro-
priations or allocations authorized made by law, ~~and a~~
~~regular statement and account of the receipts and expenditures~~
~~of all public money,~~ shall be published at the commencement
~~of the biennial session of the Legislature.~~"
