SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 996, L. D. 1437, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Safety Seat Belts for Automobiles and
School Buses."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated
"Sec. 38-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

"'Sec. 38-A. Safety seat belts in new vehicles. A passenger
automobile or school bus, which is manufactured or assembled
commencing with the 1965 models and which is purchased at retail,
shall be equipped by the purchaser with safety seat belts within
10 days after the purchase. Such passenger automobile shall be
equipped with safety belts installed for use in the left front and
right front seats thereof and such school bus shall be equipped
with safety belts installed for use in all seats.'"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in that part designated
"Sec. 38-B." the last underlined sentence.
