SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 996, L. D. 1437, "An Act Providing
for Safety Seat Belts for Automobiles and School Buses."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "and
School Buses"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "Sec. 38-A." and inserting in place thereof the follow-
ing:

"Sec. 38-A. Safety seat belts in new vehicles. A passenger
automobile, which is manufactured or assembled commencing with the
1965 models and which is purchased at retail, shall be equipped by
the purchaser with safety seat belts within 10 days after the
purchase. Such passenger automobile shall be equipped with
safety belts installed for use in the left front and right front
seats thereof."

Further amend said Bill by striking out in that part
designated "Sec. 38-B." the last underlined sentence.
