**AN ACT Prohibiting a General Contractor to Bid Unless Able to Perform Part
of Work.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 26, amended. Section 26 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by section 2 of chapter 234 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'No agency of the State shall enter into any contract for a public improvement, nor shall any of its instrumentalities enter into any contract for buildings or public works, with a general contractor unless the contract shall provide that the general contractor shall not subcontract more than 75% of the total bid price, exclusive of the total price of the sub-contracts called for in the proposal.'
