AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Skunks and Raccoons in the Daytime.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ IV-A, additional. Section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection IV-A, to read as follows:

'IV-A. Skunk and raccoon in daytime. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt skunks and raccoons, except that skunks and raccoons may be hunted during the period from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset from August 15th to December 15th of each year.'
