COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 527, L. D. 1448, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution Forbidding Discrimination
Against Any Person because of Race, Religion, Sex or
Ancestry.

Amend said Resolve in the title by striking out the words
"because of Race, Religion, Sex or Ancestry"

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the last
2 underlined lines of section 6-A and inserting in place thereof the
following:

"discriminated against in the exercise thereof."

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 2nd
paragraph of the referendum and inserting in place thereof the
following:

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a
resolution of the Legislature Forbidding Discrimination Against Any
Person?"
