HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 530, L.D. 1451, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution Designating Procedure
for Determining the Election of Governor.

Amend said Resolve in that part designated "Section 3."
by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines the underlined words
and punctuation "together with the ballots cast if they so elect.";
and by striking out the single quotation mark at the end of the
19th line and inserting in place thereof the following underlined
sentence:

"The Supreme Judicial Court, on appeal, shall determine the
validity of any disputed ballots.' "
