SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1022, L. D. 1478, Bill, "An Act
Clarifying the Inland Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 9, a new section 9-A,
as follows:

"Sec. 9-A. R. S., c. 37, §39, sub-§IX-A, additional.

Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is
amended by adding a new subsection IX-A, as follows:

'IX-A. Free permits for patients at Pineland Hospital
and Training Center. The commissioner is authorized to
issue free fishing permits covering groups of patients
at the Pineland Hospital and Training Center. These permits
shall be issued on request of the Superintendent of the
Pineland Hospital and Training Center, shall be effective
while such groups are being conducted by a representative
of the Pineland Hospital and Training Center and while such
groups are fishing within a 25-mile radius of New Gloucester.'"
