SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 1022, L. D. 1478, Bill, "An Act
Clarifying the Inland Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 30 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 30, R. S., c. 37, §113, sub-§IV, repealed and replaced.
Subsection IV of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes,
as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'IV. Raccoon and skunk. Raccoons and skunks may be hunted
during the period from August 15th to December 15th of each year.
Hunting of raccoons and skunks from 1/2 hour after sunset to
1/2 hour before sunrise during said period may be done under
the following conditions:

- A. The hunter must be accompanied by a dog;
- B. An electric flashlight of not more than 3 cells may be
used while locating or taking the animal found by a dog;and
- C. No firearm may be in the possession of the hunter
except a pistol using no greater power than .22 caliber
long rifle ammunition may be used.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 31.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 32 to 38 to be
sections 31 to 37.
