Further amend said Bill by correcting the totals therein affected by the adoption of this amendment.

Further amend said Bill by inserting in section 1 thereof immediately preceding the tabulation captioned:

"GENERAL FUND

APPROPRIATIONS FROM GENERAL FUND"

two new paragraphs to read as follows:

'It is the intent of the Legislature that operations of dormitories and dining facilities at the teachers colleges shall be operated on a self-supporting basis and that revenues accruing from the operation of such dormitories and dining facilities shall be credited to special revenue accounts which shall be established on the books of the State for that purpose. The State Board of Education shall charge rates for room rentals, sale of meals, and other dormitory fees which are uniform among all colleges and the said board is authorized to make such adjustments among the said special revenue accounts as may be necessary to provide each college with the funds necessary for the operation of the dormitories and dining facilities on a self-supporting basis with no further recourse to the general fund. The number of employees authorized for the operation of dormitory and dining facilities in the preparation of the Budget Document are authorized to be considered as permanent employees.

It further is the intent of the Legislature that bookstores at the teachers colleges shall be operated on a self-supporting revolving fund basis through working capital funds which shall be established on the books of the State and, to provide an initial capital, permanent working capital advances from unappropriated surplus may be made upon authorization of the Governor and Council in an amount which shall not exceed \$25,000 in the aggregate nor for any college in excess of the tabulated amounts shown below:

Gorham State Teachers College	7,500

Fort Kent State Teachers College	2,000
Aroostook State Teachers College	5,000'
