HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1024, L. D. 1485, Bill, "An
Act Relating to Proceedings in Adoption of Children."

Amend said Bill in the 4th line by inserting after the
underlined word and punctuation "child," the following
underlined words and punctuation 'unless one of the
petitioners is a blood relative of the child or the petitioners
have received the child from the Department of Health and
Welfare or from a licensed adoption agency,'

Further amend said Bill in the 9th line by inserting after
the underlined word and period "child." the following underlined
sentence:

'The court may refer any petition signed by a blood relative
to said department.'
