SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1026, L. D. 1487, Resolve, In Favor of
Town of Woolwich for Rent of Certain Property Owned by State.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by striking out the words
"for Rent of Certain Property Owned by State"

Further amend said Resolve by striking out everything after
the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Town of Woolwich; reimbursed.'

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated
Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to the
Town of Woolwich as settlement of the town's claim against the
State by the acquisition of certain property by the State.'
