STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Driver Education for Certain Applicants for Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60-A, amended. The first sentence of section 60-A of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 221 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'After the first day of September, 1960, no No operator's license shall be issued to any person under 17 years of age, or after the 15th day of September, 1964, to any person under 19 years of age, who has not previously held a valid operator's license issued by this or another state or province, unless such person shall present a certificate of successful completion of a driver education course and examination given by the public secondary schools and academies receiving tuition students as described in chapter 41, section 107; or certificate of successful completion of a driver education course and examination given by some person or persons licensed by the Secretary of State.'
