HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1038, L. D. 1505, Bill, "An
Act Prohibiting the Use of Live Birds and Animals
for Certain Purposes."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 9-A. Birds and animals prohibited for certain
purposes. It shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, offer
as premium or display within this State any live animals or
live birds of any kind under 4 weeks of age in quantities of
less than 12. Whoever violates this section shall be punished
by a fine of not more than \$50."
