HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1038, L. D. 1505, Bill, "An
Act Prohibiting the Use of Live Birds and Animals for
Certain Purposes."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the
words "and Animals"

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

" ' Sec. 9-A. Birds prohibited for certain purposes.
It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to
sell, offer for sale or give away within this State any baby
chicks or ducklings 2 weeks old or younger in quantities of
less than 6. Whoever violates this section shall be punished
by a fine of not more than \$50.' "
