STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of Live Birds and Animals for Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § **9-A, additional.** Chapter 140 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 9-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 9-A. Birds and animals prohibited for certain purposes. It shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, give away or display within this State any live animals or live birds of any kind which have been dyed or otherwise artificially colored. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.'
