SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1045, L. D. 1512, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Binders on Pulpwood, Logs or Bolts Hauled in
Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the amending clause and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., c. 22, §94, amended. The first sentence of section 94
of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following
enacted in place thereof:'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the single
quotation mark, the following underlined sentence: 'Each vehicle
or trailer shall carry a solid-boarded tailboard or 5 stakes evenly
spaced of sufficient strength to maintain the weight of the load, and
such load at no place along its length shall be higher than the
tailboard or stakes.'
