RESOLVE, Providing State Pension for Guy C. Brown of Portland.

Guy C. Brown; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month is granted to Guy C. Brown, of Portland, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1963 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Brown is an out-patient from the Augusta State Hospital. He is living with his elderly mother and stepfather who live on social security. Mr. Brown is 60 years of age.
