**AN ACT Prohibiting Throwing of Rocks at any Public or Private
Transportation Conveyance.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 131, § 26-A, additional. Chapter 131 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 26-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 26-A. Throwing rocks at transportation vehicles. Whoever willfully, maliciously or wantonly propels by any means whatsoever a rock, stone, bullet or any other substance or missile at any automobile, train, bus, truck or other form of public or private conveyance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.'
