AN ACT Clarifying the Labeling of Canned Food.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 32-A, § 26, amended. The 2nd sentence of the next to the last paragraph of section 26 of chapter 32-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 142 of the public laws of 1963, is amended to read as follows:

‘Such information shall appear on the principal display panel of the package, **or, on canned food label, a panel devoted solely to information pertinent to the product.**’

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature.
