AN ACT Relating to a Permit for Processing of Imported Lobster Meat Under Bond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37-A, § 72, sub-§ II, ¶ E, amended. Paragraph E of subsection II of section 72 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'E. The dealer who purchases such meat is required to file a monthly statement of shipments received with the commissioner on forms furnished by the commissioner may, notwithstanding the other provisions of this chapter, obtain a permit for the processing of such lobster meat if it conforms to the legal standards of the states or countries from which it originates, provided that the processor gives bond to the commissioner that such meat shall not be sold within the State and that he will comply with all rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner covering transportation and processing of such meat. The word "Maine" shall not appear on the package in which such lobster meat is sold or offered for sale. The commissioner may prescribe such reasonable rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this subsection.'

Sec. 2. Expiration date. This act shall expire September 1, 1965.
