SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1058, L. D. 1523, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Election Recounts."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after paragraph B of
subsection I a new underlined paragraph B-1, to read as follows:

'B-1. If the combined vote is 5,001 to 10,000 the
percentage of difference between the vote must be 4%
or less of the total vote.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the
first line of paragraph C of subsection I the underlined figure
"5,001" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '10,001'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after
paragraph B of subsection II a new underlined paragraph B-1, to
read as follows:

'B-1. If the combined vote is 5,001 to 10,000, and
the percentage of difference between the vote for
the 2 candidates is more than 4%, \$100.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the
first line of paragraph C of subsection II the underlined figure
"5,001" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '10,001'
