AN ACT Relating to Travel Allowance for Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 116, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1955 and by chapter 232 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 8. Fees. Grand and traverse jurors attending the Superior Court and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law shall be allowed \$12 ~~for each day's actual attendance~~ per day and 10c a mile for their travel out and home ~~once each week~~ for the first day of attendance and 5c a mile for their travel out and home for each day's attendance thereafter, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
