SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 585, L. D. 1542, Bill, "An Act to
Revise the Boating Law and Extend Boat Registration and
Safety Law to Cover Coastal Waters."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 7." of
section 1 by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following
underlined sentence:

'This section shall not apply to motorboats for hire which have
satisfactorily passed an annual examination by the United States
Coast Guard Auxiliary.'
