SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 583, L. D. 1548, Bill, "An Act Revising
Certain Laws Under the Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the under-
lined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined paragraph:

"An employee sustaining personal injury by accident arising out
of and in the course of his employment shall be entitled to reasonable
and proper medical, surgical and hospital services, nursing, medicines and
mechanical, surgical aids, as needed, paid for by the employer."

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 1, the fol-
lowing section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 31, §9, amended. The last paragraph of sec-
tion 9 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-
lows:

'Whenever there is any disagreement as to the proper costs of the
the services or aids ~~afesaid~~, or the periods during which they shall
be furnished, or as to the apportionment thereof among the parties, any
interested person may file a petition with the commission for the
determination thereof.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 10." of
section 2 by striking out in the 4th line the underlined figure "14"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '21'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 6 to be
sections 3 to 7.
