HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 607, L. D. 1571, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Percentage by Weight of Alcohol of Blood of
Operators of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
sections:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 66, §9-B, additional. Chapter 66 of
the Revised Statutes is amended by adding thereto a new section
9-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 9-B. Further immunity. No person licensed under
this chapter, who in the exercise of due care withdraws blood
from a defendant for the purpose of determining the alcoholic
content therein under chapter 22, section 150, shall be liable
for any civil damages as a result of acts or omissions by such
person in withdrawing such blood.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 71, §15, additional. Chapter 71 of the
Revised Statutes is amended by adding thereto a new section 15,
to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Further immunity. No person licensed under this
chapter, who in the exercise of due care withdraws blood from a
defendant for the purpose of determining the alcoholic content
therein under chapter 22, section 150, shall be liable for any
civil damages as a result of acts or omissions by such person
in withdrawing such blood.' "
