HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 607, L.D. 1571, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Percentage by Weight of Alcohol of Blood
of Operators of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 150." by
adding at the end of the first paragraph thereof the following
underlined sentence: 'Notwithstanding the provisions of this
paragraph, any such person may petition the Secretary of State
upon revocation of a license or permit, and upon hearing, the
Secretary of State, if he determines that the license or permit
is necessary for the petitioner's livelihood, may issue a
restricted license to the petitioner to be used only in the
course of his employment.'
